This is MK Gallery.

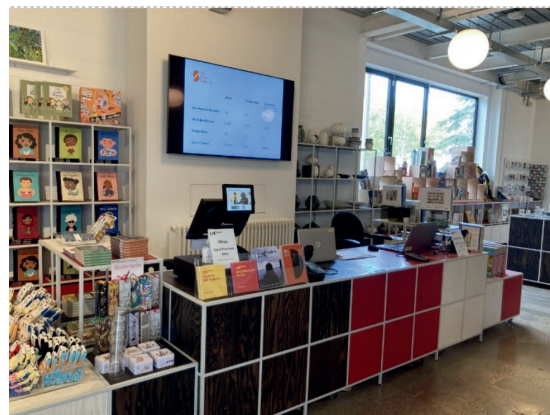


The film I am going to see starts at 10:30am.
