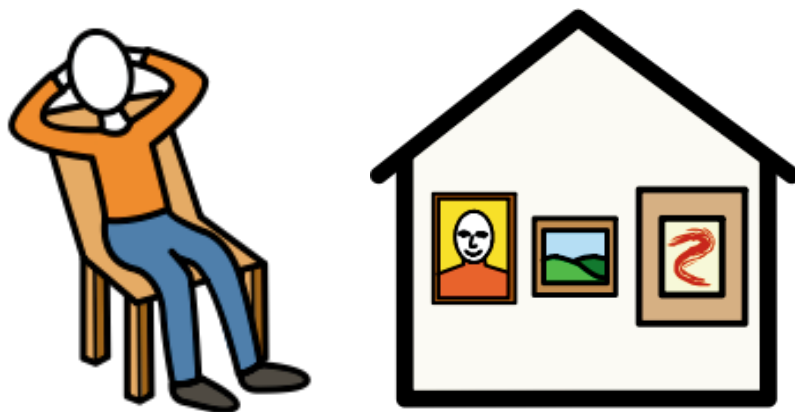




I am going to a SEND Exhibition Tour at MK Gallery!



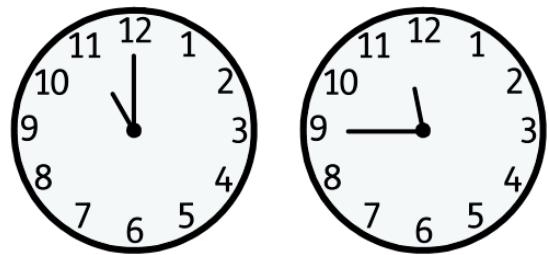


On Saturday, I am going to a SEND Exhibition Tour at MK Gallery.

I will also be using my senses to explore the MK Gallery building in new ways with Julia!



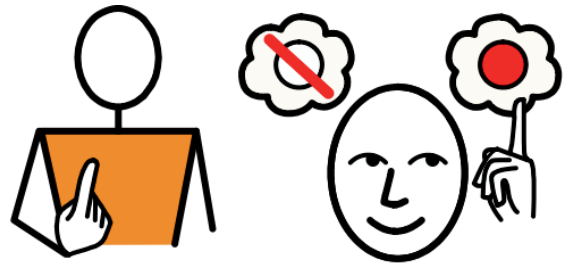
Julia will have lots of exciting things for me to smell, touch, hear, see, and even taste!



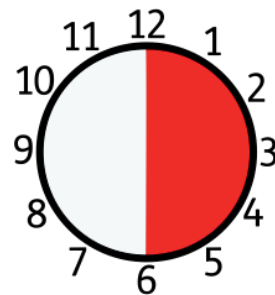
There will be other people with me on my tour. They might be with their families, or companions.
