MK Gallery!**






On Sunday, I am going to a Relaxed Exhibition Viewing at MK Gallery.

This is MK Gallery.




The relaxed opening hour is from 10-11am.

The exhibition I will be exploring is called To Improvise A Mountain: Lynette Yiadom-Boakye Curates.




This is a group exhibition with artworks by lots of different artists!






All of the artworks were chosen by an artist called Lynette Yiadom-Boakye. Lynette is a painter, you can see her work in the exhibition too.



There are five gallery spaces full of artwork for me to explore.



There is information on the walls for me to read.



Or I can listen to an MK Gallery volunteer reading the information, using the Bloomberg Connects app on a phone or tablet!






There are benches to sit down on throughout the galleries.




Two of the Galleries contain video artworks. These spaces are very dark.



The sound will be adjusted on these artworks so they are not too loud.



Once I get to the end of the exhibition, I will need to walk back through the Galleries, and leave the same way I entered.





If I need to use the toilet while I am at MK Gallery, I can follow the WC signs to get there.



There is also a Changing Places Facility I can use if I'd like to. A member of MK Gallery staff can show me the way.



If I feel like I need a movement break or some fresh air while I am at MK Gallery, I can use the Playscape.
