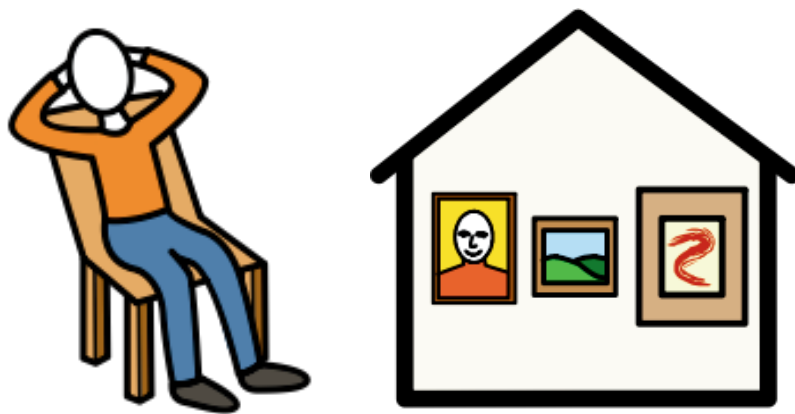




I am going to a Relaxed Exhibition Viewing at MK Gallery!



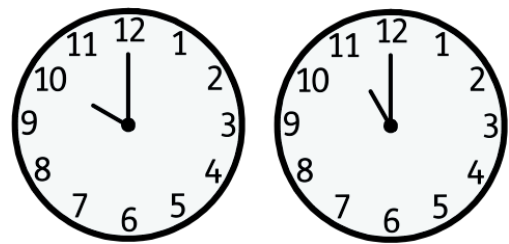


On Sunday, I am going to a Relaxed Exhibition Viewing at MK Gallery.

This is MK Gallery.

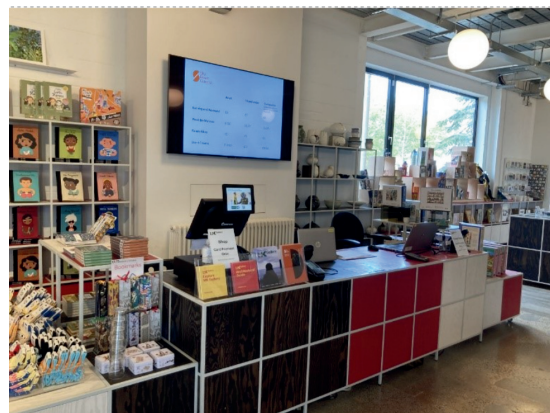


The relaxed opening hour is from 10-11am.

If I would like to, I can borrow a Sensory Scout Kit to take around the exhibition with me.

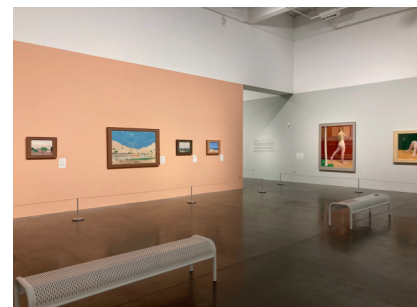
I can find them in a wooden box by the exhibition entrance.

Euan Uglow was an important British painter.





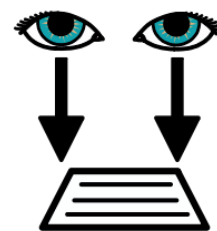
He mostly painted large scale nude portraits, as well as landscape paintings and still life images.

There is information on the walls for me to read.

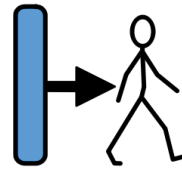


There are benches to sit down on throughout the galleries.
