The resources in each box were chosen, design and made by students from St Paul's Catholic School VI Department.



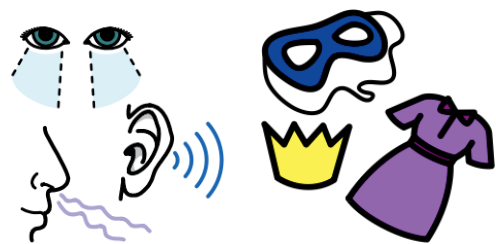
Artist and MK Gallery Sensory Tour Guide Julia Collar collaborated with the students on this project.



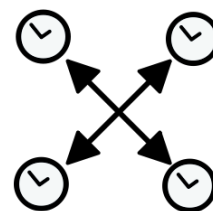
There is also a Yoto player with an audio guide, and a written guide with Widgit symbols to help me explore the Sensory Tour Kit.



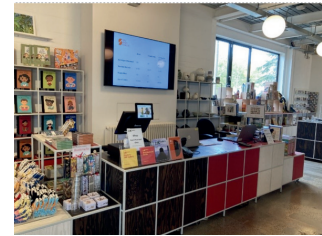
There are lots of exciting things inside the boxes! Things to smell, touch, dress up in, and more!
